

Parks and Recreation Board

The Parks and Recreation Board has the responsibility to organize and advise the City Commission on the use of the city property being used for parks and recreational activities. The board establishes the rules, regulations, policies, fees, and other charges associated for the use of the city's recreational facilities.

The board members of the Parks and Recreation Board consist of seven members. Each board member is appointed by the City Commission and each member shall serve a three year term. A board member may be removed from the board without notice and without assignment of cause by a majority vote of the City Commission. The board shall meet every other month of each year.

General Employees' Retirement Board

The General Employees' Retirement Board is responsible for the management, operation, and administration of the City retirement plan. The Board of Trustees appoints actuaries, supervises the distribution of assets, maintains service records, provides direction for the payment of benefits, compiles and distributes all statements, reports, and forms necessary for administration of the plan.

The board consists of seven trustees; three residents that are appointed by the City Commission, three general employees of the City of Lake Alfred who are a part of the retirement plan, and the seventh is appointed by the other six members of the retirement board. Each member of the Lake Alfred General Employees' Retirement Board shall serve a three year term. The board shall meet every quarter of each year.

Police and Fire Retirement Board

The Police and Fire Retirement Board is responsible for management, operation, and administration of the City retirement plan. The Board of Trustees appoints actuaries, supervises the distribution of assets, maintains service records, provides direction for the payment of benefits, compiles and distributes all statements, reports, and forms necessary for administration of the plan.

The board consists of five trustees; two residents are appointed by the City Commission, two police and fire employees of the City of Lake Alfred and who are a part of the retirement plan, and the fifth is appointed by the other four members of the retirement board. Each member of the Lake Alfred General Employees' Retirement Board shall serve a four year term. The board shall meet every quarter of each year.
